

What do I do if I find myself in a Domestic Violence situation during COVID-19?

- Call 911, Wichita Police will continue to respond to Domestic Violence situations.

What happens if my roommate or spouse is arrested for a domestic violence charge in Municipal Court?

- The Court will order a 72 hour no contact order which will take effect upon the defendant’s release from jail.
- The defendant will be given a court date upon release. Appearance dates are being set into May following the court’s closure.

What do I do if I want to extend the 72 hour no contact order?

You will need to obtain a Protection from Abuse (PFA) or Protection from Stalking (PFS) order.

- To obtain court paperwork for a PFA go to DC18.org, or contact your court advocate who can email it to you.
- Completed forms need to be emailed or faxed to the Sedgwick County District Court. famlaw_assignment@dc18.org or by FAX at 316-941-5354.
