

# Reopening of City Facilities

City of Wichita has developed plans for the gradual and safe reopening of facilities and services to the public. These plans are flexible and will be responsive to ensure the health and well-being of staff and residents. Many facilities are opening with modifications to accommodate social distancing and safety protocols. ## Riverside Tennis Center

Effective June 1, Wichita Park & Recreation will be opening Riverside Tennis Center for play, with restrictions in place to avoid the spread of COVID-19 to staff and guests.

A list of safety guidelines will be imposed, and players will need to follow social distancing practices.

Restrictions set for Riverside Tennis Center include:

- Guests are asked to pay court reservations online at [Wichita.gov/Evolve](http://Wichita.gov/Evolve) or call 316-337-9257 and pay over the phone
- Clubhouse is restricted to no more than five people at one time
- Restrooms are open, although showers will not be available
- Guests are required to wear masks in clubhouse
- No cash payments, only credit or debit cards
- All players must practice social distancing of six feet or more
- Arrive no more than five minutes before your scheduled time
- Please exit the facility immediately after your rental or lesson is completed
- Limited concession items are available
- Pro Shop merchandise is available for sale with staff assistance
- No trash cans, water coolers or benches will be available on the courts
