

Funding and Change Order Limit Adjustment for Improvements to 29th Street North & Maize Road (District V)

- **Background** – On January 22, 2019 the City Council approved a design agreement with Baughman Company for development of a design concept to improve the 29th and Maize Rd. intersection. On June 4, 2019, the City Council approved the design concept, Supplemental Design Agreement No. 1, and additional funding to complete final design and purchase of easements.
- **Analysis** – The existing left turns for 29th Street North become inaccessible during the peak hours due to the limited length of the turn lanes and volume of through traffic. Traffic counts for northbound Maize Road to eastbound 29th Street North are high enough that a dedicated right turn lane is needed. These improvements are the most needed at this time and will outlive the lifespan of the existing pavement. All other traffic movements can be accommodated within the existing intersection geometrics.
- **Financial Considerations/Recommended Action** – The Adopted 2019-2028 CIP includes \$1,070,000 in 2019, \$300,000 of which was already approved. Request balance of \$770,000 for total budget of \$1,070,000. Approve the revised budget and the change order limit adjustment, adopt the amending resolution, and authorize the necessary signatures.
