# Application Timeline



- June 4, 2020 - Received application for Automobilia Moonlight Charity Car Show Community Event
- Application was dated April 15, 2020 but not received until June; application not complete
- June 9 - Due to change in event footprint, email sent to approvers for issues with street closures
- June 16 - Email to Joshua Blick about missing information



## Timeline, continued



- June 17 - Received some of missing information, several emails back and forth regarding missing information
- June 19 - Received liability insurance information
- June 23 - Payment for permit received
- June 23 -Received complaint from business regarding street closure
- June 24 – Assistant City Manager Donte Martin reviewed the application and denied permit based upon public safety risk.
- June 25 – Denial letter mailed



## Analysis of COVID-19 Data



- Based on data from Sedgwick County, on June 22 we had **250** cases
- July 6 Sedgwick County has **775** cases; **41** from the weekend
- Test results indicate the number of infected persons is growing; the disease is spreading
- A larger portion of the population has become infected based upon percentage of positive tests




## What the Data Indicates:



- Public safety concerns are raised by the potential risk of allowing 20,000 people in a confined area
- Accordingly, the Automobilia community event does not meet the criteria set forth in Section 3.11.080(b) of the City Code, as it presents a public safety hazard
- Pursuant to Section 3.11.090(a), the prudent action was to deny the community event permit application



# SEDGWICK COUNTY COVID-19 (Updated 7/1/20)



## Recommendation



- The Automobilia Moonlight Charity Carshow presents a public safety hazard, due to the COVID-19 virus
- Based upon this hazard, the appeal of staff's denial of the Community Event Permit should be denied.
