Background




- On July 3, 2020, the City Council adopted a mandatory mask ordinance, which required citizens to wear masks when in public places.
- The original ordinance was set to expire on August 11, 2020.
- At that time, the ordinance was extended until September 8, 2020.

Ordinance Specifics



- The amended ordinance extends the requirements that masks be worn in public places until October 21, 2020.
- Due to the prior ordinance expiring on September 8, 2020, it is necessary to declare a public emergency and pass the ordinance on first reading.



Recommendation Action



- It is recommended that the City Council declare an emergency and approve the Ordinance Amending Section 5.43.050 pertaining to Wearing of Masks in Public Places on the first reading.
