Section Engineer (Traffic Engineer)

The City of Wichita Public Works and Utilities department is the largest public utility in the State of Kansas.

The Position

This is highly technical, professional and administrative work. This employee oversees the Traffic Engineering Section, as part of the Engineering Division and is responsible for applying engineering principles and techniques to the solution of traffic problems. The Traffic Engineer is responsible for setting signal timings for approximately 500 intersections, overseeing ongoing projects to upgrade the traffic signal network, working with field staff to coordinate installation of

traffic control devices, oversight of permitted work within rights-of-way, and oversees the streetlight budget. The Traffic Engineer will ideally have knowledge of the American's with Disabilities Act (ADA) and application of the same to transportation facilities. Work is directed and reviewed through the establishment of goals and subsequent evaluation of progress toward goal attainment. This employee reports directly to the Assistant City Engineer.

Required Experience and Training

Graduation from a four-year college with a degree in civil engineering, traffic engineering, or a closely related engineering field, plus four years of experience in the traffic and transportation field, preferably in municipal traffic engineering, with at least two of those in a supervisor capacity. Registration as a Licensed Professional Civil Engineer in the State of Kansas is required. An equivalent combination of education, experience and training may be considered. Offers of employment are contingent upon passing a pre-employment physical, which includes drug screening, and upon satisfactory evaluation of the results of a criminal record check.
