NEW BUSINESS

5. Pedestrian Master Plan Scott Knebel

Scott Knebel, Metropolitan Area Planning Department, will present the draft Wichita Pedestrian Master Plan. The Plan is proposed to be a 10-year guide for how the City of Wichita can improve conditions for walking. Over the 18 past months, more than 50 events have been held with opportunities for individuals to participate in the planning process. The Plan includes a vision, actions, priorities, design guidance, and performance measures. The Plan document and related materials are available online at www.wichita.gov.

*******Recommended Action:** It is recommended that the DAB recommend endorsement of the Plan by the Wichita City Council.

6. Market and Topeka Bicycle Lane Scott Knebel

Within the adopted 2011-2020 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) the Wichita Bicycle Master Plan has proposed a project that will provide on-street bicycle lanes on Market and Topeka from Kellogg to 17th Street. The project will also provide on-street bicycle lanes on 17th Street from Topeka to Market and on Market north to 21st Street. There will be minimal impact to on-street parking. Construction is planned to begin in fall 2014.

*******Recommended Action:** Based upon information available staff recommends the approval of the proposed bicycle lane project.

7. First and Second Street Bicycle Lane Scott Knebel

Within the adopted 2011-2020 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) the Wichita Bicycle Master Plan has proposed a project that will provide on-street bicycle lanes on First and Second Streets from Grove to Wichita Street. The project will continue south on Wichita Street to First Street, then west to Seneca. Construction is planned to begin in fall 2014.

*******Recommended Action:** Based upon information available staff recommends the approval of the proposed bicycle lane project.

8. ZON2014-00015 Jess McNeely

Applicant **Blake Byfield** is requesting a city zone change from SF-5 Single-family Residential to MF-18 Multi-family. The proposed property is located at 708 N. Anna Street

*******Recommended Action:** Based upon information available prior to the public hearings, planning staff recommends that the request be approved based on findings listed in the staff report

9. ZON2014-00018 Bill Longnecker

Applicant **Alice R. Graham and agent Baughman Company** are requesting a city zone change from SF-5 Single-family Residential to TF-3 Two-family. The proposed property is located at 1250 N. Curtis St.
