ORDINANCE NO.50-291

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 11.48.180 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO SALE OF UNCLAIMED OR IMPOUNDED BICYCLES AND REPEALING THE ORIGINAL OF SAID SECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Section 11.48.180 of the Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 11.48.180. - Sale of unclaimed or impounded bicycles.

Whenever a bicycle has been impounded for a period of 30 days and no claim of ownership or the right to possession thereof has been made and established to the satisfaction of the police department, such bicycle may be sold at public auction or distributed to benefit public welfare at the discretion of the Wichita Police Department after legal publication of the time, date and location of such sale or disposition.

SECTION 2. The original of Section 11.48.180 of the Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be included in the Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas, and shall be effective upon its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
