

RESOLUTION NO. 15-378

A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 15-153 OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, WHICH AMENDED SECTIONS 1 AND 2 OF RESOLUTION 15-007 OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, WHICH AUTHORIZED THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS TO PAY THE COSTS OF, CERTAIN PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City of Wichita, Kansas (the “City”) is a municipal corporation, duly created, organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the state of Kansas; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body is authorized, pursuant to K.S.A. 13-1024c, as amended by Charter Ordinance No. 156 of the City (the “Act”) to issue general obligation bonds of the City without an election for the purpose of paying for the construction, purchase or improvement of any public property, including the land necessary therefore, and for the purpose of rebuilding, adding to or extending the same as the necessities of the City may require and for the purpose of paying for certain personal property therefore; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 15-153 of the City of Wichita, Kansas (the “Prior Resolution”), the Governing Body hereby found and determined it necessary and advisable to make certain public improvements described as follows:

General Repairs to City Facilities. Including but not limited to Cessna Park restroom and shelter, Evergreen Library, Evergreen pool house, Gander Mountain parking garage, Lawrence Dumont Stadium, Central Library, Mid-America All-Indian Center, Orchard pool house, Wichita Art Museum, and unscheduled projects.

(including but not limited to replacement of heating, ventilation and cooling systems (HVAC), plumbing/water system upgrades, fountain equipment/system replacements, structural repairs, window and door replacement, and electrical component replacements within City Facilities, collectively, the “Project”) and to provide for the payment of all or a portion of the costs thereof by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City pursuant to the Act; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body now finds it necessary to decrease the amounts that may be expended and financed for the costs of the Project.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment. *Section 1* of the Prior Resolution is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Amendment. *Section 1 and Section 2* of Resolution No. 15-007 of the City of Wichita, Kansas are hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Project Authorization. It is hereby determined that it is necessary and advisable to make certain public improvements described as follows:

General Repairs to City Facilities. Including but not limited to Cessna Park restroom and shelter, Evergreen Library, Evergreen pool house, Gander Mountain parking garage, Lawrence Dumont Stadium, Central Library, City Hall, Mid-America All-Indian Center, Orchard pool house, Wichita Art Museum, and unscheduled projects.

(including but not limited to replacement of heating, ventilation and cooling systems (HVAC), plumbing/water system upgrades, fountain equipment/system replacements, roof and structural repairs, window and door replacement, carpet replacement and electrical component replacements within City Facilities (collectively, the “Amended Project”) and to provide for the payment of all or a portion of the costs thereof by the issuance of general obligation bonds of the City pursuant to the Act, and it is hereby further authorized, ordered and directed that the Amended Project be acquired and/or constructed at an estimated cost of \$2,895,000 in accordance with plans and specifications therefor prepared under the direction of the Fleet & Facilities Superintendent and approved by the Governing Body; said plans and specifications to be placed on file in the office of the Fleet & Facilities Superintendent.

Section 2. Project Financing. All or a portion of the costs of the Project, interest on financing and administrative and financing costs shall be financed with the proceeds of general obligation bonds of the City (the “Bonds”). The Bonds may be issued to reimburse expenditures authorized by Resolution No. 15-007 of the City of Wichita, Kansas, which were made on or after the date which was 60 days before the January 6, 2015 date of adoption of Resolution No. 15-007, and to reimburse additional expenditures authorized by the Prior Resolution, which were made on or after a date 60 days before the date of adoption of the Prior Resolution, all pursuant to Treasury Regulation §1.150-2.

Section 2. Repealer; Ratification. *Section 1* of the Prior Resolution, as it previously existed, is hereby repealed and replaced with the amended text set forth in Section 1, above; and the rest and remainder of the operative text of the Prior Resolution is hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption by the Governing Body.
