

ADVERTISING - VEHICULAR

BASIS Any person engaged in advertising by radio, public address system, loud speaker or other sound-producing device, sign, banner, poster, person or any advertising device placed on any automobile, truck, wagon, or other vehicle which shall be operated upon the streets of the city.

LEGAL REFERENCE Chapter 3.64, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

REGULATIONS Vehicles used for advertising by means of sound-producing devices shall be prohibited in the congested district; provided, however, that any person operating his own vehicle upon which he carries the sign or advertising of his own property shall be exempt from the provisions of this section.

The congested district shall be defined as follows:

That district bounded by Lewis Street, the Arkansas River, Central Avenue and the elevated tracks, Douglas Avenue from the Arkansas River to Seneca Street. Douglas Avenue from the elevated tracks to Hydraulic.

Vehicles on which sound-producing devices are used shall not be allowed to operate between the hours of 8 p.m. and 8 a.m., and such vehicles shall not be permitted to park on the streets or alleys for the purpose of advertising

ENFORCING AUTHORITY Police Department

FEES

Per day, per vehicle.....	\$ 2.00
Per week, per vehicle.....	5.00
Per six months, per vehicle.....	25.00

Any person operating in excess of five vehicles may, in lieu of the license provided above for the individual vehicles, obtain a fleet license and pay the following per six months:

More than 5 but less than 25 vehicles.....	\$ 50.00
More than 25 but less than 50 vehicles.....	100.00
More than 50.....	*100.00

*Plus \$1.00 for each vehicle over 50.

No fee will be charged but a license will be issued to political, religious, charitable or non-profit organizations.
