

**EMERGENCY WRECKER OPERATOR**

---

**BASIS** It shall be unlawful for any person to report for and make an emergency wrecker tow unless the operator of the wrecker shall have in their possession an operator's certificate.

**LEGAL REFERENCE** Chapter 3.49, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas

**REGULATIONS** Applicant must:

- 1) Be at least 18 years of age.
- 2) Be a person of good moral character.

A license will not be issued to any person who:

- 1) Made false or misleading statements of fact in the application;
- 2) Within five years of the date of application had an operator's certificate revoked;
- 3) Is now registered as a sex offender with any state;
- 4) Within five years preceding the date of the application has been found guilty of, pleaded guilty to, pleaded nolo contendere to or been convicted of a federal, state or local law of any city for leaving the scene of a motor vehicle accident or driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs, or
- 5) Within five years preceding the date of application has been found guilty of, pleaded guilty to, pleaded nolo contendere to or has been convicted of a felony.

Background check fees are nonrefundable for any reason. Certificates are renewed two years from the date of issue.

Certificates are nontransferable from one individual to another, or by an individual from one individual to another, or by one individual from employment by one emergency wrecker service company to employment with another emergency wrecker service company.

An individual may hold multiple permits allowing such individual to be employed by more than one emergency wrecker service company, however, no additional permit will be issued without written authorization from all emergency wrecker service companies with which the individual is or seeks to be permitted.
