

**FIREWORKS DISPLAY AND AERIAL SALUTES  
and  
INDOOR PYROTECHNIC SPECIAL EFFECTS MATERIAL**

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**BASIS** A person engaged in the display of fireworks, the use of pyrotechnic special effects material, or an indoor pyrotechnic display in the City of Wichita.

**LEGAL REFERENCE** Section 105 of the 2006 International Fire Code, Sections 15.01.650 through Section 15.01.680 of the Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

**REGULATIONS** Application to be filed at least 14 days, but not more than 60 days, prior to the date of the display.

The applicant is to file the application, fee, site map, product inventory and number to be used, and a Fireworks Display Operator or Pyrotechnic Operator certificate. A site map is a diagram of the grounds on which the display is to be held showing the point at which the fireworks are to be discharged; the location of buildings, highways, and other lines of communication; the lines behind which the audience will be restrained; and the location of nearby trees, telegraph or telephone lines and other overhead obstructions. For indoor displays, the permit application shall include a diagram of the location and a plan or the use of the pyrotechnic material.

The Fireworks Display applicants are required to present a valid Fireworks Display Operator certificate issued by the State of Kansas Fire Marshal's Office. Pyrotechnic special effect material applicants are required to present a valid Pyrotechnic Operator certificate issued by the State of Kansas Fire Marshal's Office.

The applicant shall file with the City Clerk a corporate surety bond or with the City Treasurer for the benefit of the City a public liability insurance policy with coverage of not less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) for injury or death to persons or injury to property.
