

Advance Plans Committee Meeting Summary

Discussion Summary

1. The Advance Plans Committee approved the summary of the February 4, 2016 Committee meeting.
2. Staff briefed the Committee on the outcome of the Community Building Blocks technical assistance workshop held on February 23rd and 24th. Over 80 people attended the community meeting on Tuesday night and 33 invited representatives participated in the all-day work sessions on Wednesday. Staff expect to have the final workshop report from the consultant in the next two weeks. Staff will review the report for any final edits/ corrections and share it with the City Manager before reconvening the work session participants to begin organizing implementation efforts on the strategic action plan items. It would also be beneficial to discuss the strategic action plan items with some of our community's economic development/builders leadership to create awareness and gain their support/involvement.
3. Staff provided the Committee with an update on the development of the Wichita 2016-2025 Capital Improvement Program. A final draft CIP document has been submitted to the City Manager by the Budget Office. Over the next month or so, the City Manager will be reviewing this document with the City Council for feedback and revision. It is quite possible that the Advance Plans Committee and the MAPC will also have opportunity to review the final draft CIP sometime in April or early May.
4. Staff provided the Committee with an update on some refinements/footnotes to the plan monitoring key performance indicators associated with the National Citizens Survey. Staff also advised the Committee that the CEDBR will provide the MAPD with detailed data on 15 subcategories of high-tech industry activity in Sedgwick County, along with retail sales data breakouts by multiple sectors.
