

RODEO, PETTING ZOO AND ANIMAL EXHIBITION

BASIS Any person engaged in the business or operation of an animal exhibition, event or show, petting zoo, or rodeo on any premises or in any building or structure within the city.

DEFINITIONS Animal Exhibition means a show or exhibition with domestic animals, wild animals, or dangerous wild animals where no contact is permitted by law between spectators and the animals.

Petting Zoo means a show or exhibit of domestic animals on exhibition for physical contact with humans.

Rodeo mean a competition, exhibition or demonstration involving persons, equines and/or bovines in which participants display various skills in one or more events such as bareback riding, saddle bronco riding, steer wrestling, roping, team roping, tiedown roping, team penning, barrel racing, bull riding or similar events.

LEGAL REFERENCE Chapter 3.09 and 6.08, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas.

REGULATIONS No license shall be issued for an outdoor rodeo, except for rodeos conducted on property owned by the City of Wichita or Sedgwick County. Documentation is required that the location of the event is in compliance with zoning requirements of the Unified Zoning Code of Wichita and Sedgwick County.

Proof of liability insurance is required.

Name and address is required of licensed veterinarian responsible for the care of the animals.

License is not transferable.

Application must be submitted 20 days prior to event.

ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS FOR EXHIBITION OF DANGEROUS ANIMALS

Applicant must be a Class C USDA exhibitor (submit copy of Class C license) and in direct physical control of the animal at all times.

Police Department -Animal Control Section must be notified 5 days prior to any exhibit.

Exhibitors shall have available and present to Animal Control or state health officials copies of health records, vaccination records and ownership records for the dangerous exotic animals exhibited.

Exhibitors shall maintain liability insurance covering any exhibition in the city in the amount of at least \$250,000 and naming the City as additional insured. A copy of this insurance shall be provided prior to the exhibition.
