

TAXICAB COMPANY

BASIS Any owner or operator of vehicles carrying passengers for hire for which a public patronage is solicited and not operated over a fixed route.

LEGAL REFERENCE Chapter 3.84 and, Code of the City of Wichita, Kansas

REGULATIONS A taxicab company must have a central place of business that is staffed at least 8 hours a day for 5 days a week.

Dispatch service must be available for receiving and dispatching service 7 days a week, 24 hours a day.

The taxicab company must have a minimum of 10 vehicles used as taxicabs. Must have an insurance policy covering each and every vehicle operated.

No taxicab company license or renewal will be granted to:

- Any person who has been convicted of or has pleaded guilty to any felony within the past 5 years.
- Any person, partnership or corporation who, within the past two years, has had a license revoked.
- Any person who is not at least eighteen years of age.
- Any person who is now or has ever been registered as a sexual offender with any federal, state, county or local government.

Vehicles are to be inspected every six months by Wichita Public Works & Utilities Fleet.

Due annually before July 1, no license shall be transferred to another person or prorated.
