RESOLUTION No. 07-522

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE TO CONSTRUCT A MIDTOWN BIKE PATH ALONG THE UNION PACIFIC RAILWAY CORRIDOR FROM CENTRAL AT WACO TO 15TH AT BROADWAY (472-84562).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA,  
KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

The design and construction of a bike path, bike path rest areas and landscaping.

SECTION 2: The total cost is estimated not to exceed \$1,315,000 exclusive of the costs of interest on borrowed money, with \$600,000 paid by Federal Grants administered by the Kansas Department of Transportation and \$715,000 paid by the issuance of bonds by the City of Wichita at large.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established as authorized by K.S.A. 13-1024c and City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
