- ✓ 16 Beat-
- ✓ 18 Beat-40% decreases in larcenies from 2010. Two arrests made in vandalism crimes, appx. 90 reports made on 18, 19, 199 beats combined.
- ✓ 19 Beat- 56% decrease in larcenies from 2010. Vandalism crimes.
- ✓ 199 Beat-7.5% decreases in larcenies from 2010. Vandalism crimes.

- ✓ January 27<sup>th</sup>: State of Public Safety- increase in Community Police initiatives. All crime was down in 2010 by 5%.
