ORDINANCE NO. 47-885

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. **47-510** OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS DECLARING **MT. VERNON, BETWEEN BROADWAY AND THE ARKANSAS RIVER (472-84289)** TO BE A MAIN TRAFFICWAY WITHIN THE CITY OF WICHITA KANSAS; DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO SAID MAIN TRAFFICWAY; AND SETTING FORTH THE NATURE OF SAID IMPROVEMENTS, THE ESTIMATED COSTS THEREOF, AND THE MANNER OF PAYMENT OF THE SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. SECTION 1 of Ordinance **47-510** is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 1. It is hereby deemed and declared to be necessary by the governing body of the City of Wichita, Kansas, to make improvements to **Mt. Vernon, between Broadway and the Arkansas River (472-84289)** as a main trafficway in the follow particulars:

The design, construction of a roadway, acquisition of right-of-way, relocation of utilities installation of traffic signals, and landscaping, as necessary for a major traffic facility.

SECTION 2. SECTION 2 of Ordinance **No. 47-510** is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 2. The cost of the construction of the above described improvements is estimated to be **Four Million Dollars (\$4,000,000)** exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money, with the total paid by the City of Wichita. Said City cost, when ascertained, shall be borne by the City of Wichita at large by the issuance of General Obligation Bonds under the authority of K.S.A. 12-689.”

SECTION 3. The original SECTIONS 1 and 2 of Ordinance **No. 47-510** are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall make proper publication of this ordinance, which shall be published once in the official City paper and which shall be effective from and after said publication.
