RESOLUTION NO. 08-421

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE TO IMPLEMENT **EQUIPMENT AND FACILITY IMPROVEMENTS REQUIRED TO FACILITATE PREWETTING DURING SNOW AND ICE RESPONSE OPERATIONS.**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

- A. City of Wichita Northeast Substation (2901 E. 33<sup>rd</sup>)
  - a. Retrofit existing dump trucks with pre-wetting tanks.
  - b. Construct building to house salt brine system and related supplies.
  - c. Purchase and install stainless steel salt brine system.
  - d. Purchase and install two 10,000 gallon holding tanks.
  
- B. City of Wichita West Substation (5801 W. 3<sup>rd</sup>)
  - a. Retrofit existing dump trucks with pre-wetting tanks.
  - b. Modify existing building to house salt brine system and related supplies.
  - c. Purchase and install stainless steel salt brine system.
  - d. Purchase and install one 10,000 gallon holding tank.
  
- C. City of Wichita Central Maintenance Facility (1801 S. McLean Blvd.)
  - a. Retrofit existing dump trucks with pre-wetting tanks.
  - b. Reconstruct existing building to house salt brine system and related supplies.
  - c. Purchase and install stainless steel salt brine system.
  - d. Purchase and install one 10,000 gallon holding tank

SECTION 2: The total cost is estimated not to exceed **\$360,000**, exclusive of the costs of interest on borrowed money, with the full amount paid by the issuance of bonds by the City of Wichita at large.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established as authorized by K.S.A. 13-1024c and City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
