RESOLUTION NO. 10-245

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE TO CONSTRUCT THE REDBUD MULTI-USE PATH (472-84934).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

The design and construction of a multi-use path along the former BNSF Railway, between the I-135 Freeway and Hillside.

SECTION 2: The cost of the construction of the above described improvements is estimated to be Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money. To the extent the cost of such improvements is not paid by Federal Grants, administered by the Kansas Department of Health and Environment, the City of Wichita, Kansas is authorized to issue general obligation bonds to pay such costs up to a maximum of \$300,000, exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established and authorized by City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
