**REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Owner must not allow the dangerous dog outside the secure enclosure, as defined in section 6.04.010, unless restrained by a chain or leash, no more than four (4) feet in length, and under physical restraint by a person who is eighteen years or older and possesses sufficient physical strength to control the dog.
2. Owner must securely muzzle the dog if allowed outside the secure enclosure. The muzzle shall be made and used in a manner that will not cause injury to the dog, but shall prevent the dog from biting any human or animal.
3. Owner must have the secure enclosure approved by the Health Officer. It must be adequately lighted and kept in a clean and sanitary condition.
4. Owner shall allow the Health Officer access to the property where the dangerous animal is being harbored for inspections and insure compliance for the duration of the life of the animal.
5. Owner shall be required to surgically sterilize the dog at a licensed Veterinarian. Upon completion the owner must provide documentation of the sterilization procedure. Failure to provide documentation is a misdemeanor. If applicable, prior to release from impoundment, owner must pay for a spay/neuter voucher.
6. Owner shall be required to implant a microchip into the dangerous dog traceable to the dog and the current owner. Upon completion of the implanted microchip the owner must provide documentation to the Health Officer. Failure to provide such documentation is a misdemeanor.
7. Owner shall display in a prominent place at the entrance to his/her premises a clearly visible warning sign indicating there is a dangerous dog on the premises. A similar sign is required to be posted on the secure enclosure in which the dog is harbored.
8. Owner shall notify the Health Officer in writing a minimum of seven (7) days prior to any change in the address of the owner or location of the dog.
9. If liability insurance is required: Owner will supply certificate of liability insurance and maintain said insurance in the amount of \$100,000 insuring against the potential injury or damage liabilities and hazards associated with the ownership or possession of such dog, and shall name the City of Wichita as an additional insured.

I have read and understand the above requirements pertaining to the registration of a Dangerous Dog and agree to comply with all requirements set forth by applicable ordinances and policies established by the City of Wichita. I agree to allow the Health Officer or his/her designee access to the property where my dog is owned, kept, or harbored for the purpose of inspection and verifying compliance with the regulations and ordinances pertaining to proper animal care and maintenance. I also understand that if my previously determined dangerous dog is found running at large, attacks, or inflicts injury upon any person, the Judge of the Municipal Court shall order the dog destroyed.
