The CNAC meeting was called to order by Mike Barushok, Vice Chairperson

**Business**

- Approval of discussion summary.
- The Mission Statement was read by Mike, and encouraged everyone to keep this Statement in mind.
- Treasury Report: Willie reported a current balance of \$252.62. Motion to approve: Evelyn with a second by Patricia.
- Non Profit Status Update: There were two minor corrections in section 8. Submission of the application was deferred pending acquisition of a post office box.
- Review NA activities in support of the Central Northeast Area Plan:
  - Country Overlook is waiting on a walking path in their park. Scott is working on an environmental review. Once they receive an okay things may begin to move forward.
  - Hyde Park is planning their neighborhood cleanup. They had a school board member to speak about the school bond issue.
  - Uptown: Will be going through Neighbor-to-Neighbor training at Atwater Center on May 10<sup>th</sup>.
- Open Agenda:
  - Website: Alan has obtained an email address for CNAC. He is requesting that a digital copy of the committee members and their pictures.
- Announcements:
  - Matlock Heights: New houses are going up in the 26-2700 block of Chautauqua and Lorraine. Pat, the developer, is in financial trouble. Houses are now being rented out. Question was asked whether or not a homeowners association, which was a big factor in getting approval from the City, was ever established.
  - Uptown: Neighborhood picnic to be held on June 7<sup>th</sup>.
  - Willie advised that he met with a group of people at the Center for Health & Wellness and there will be a “Walk with the CEO” upcoming at Grove Park. It will include groups such as the Department of Aging. The CEO of the Center for Health & Wellness along with their Community on the Move will be encouraging the community to become more involved in physical activities.
