3. WPD/Community Police Report

Officer F. Tejada, WPD, reported on beats 16, 18, 19, and 199 and District V Neighborhoods.

- ✓ 18 Beat- Auto thefts. Rise in residential burglaries/ decrease in robbery crimes
- ✓ 19 – West street burglaries. DNA evidence led to an arrest.

Capt. R. Dusenbery, WFD presented on training. Medical Drill training sessions will be held at Stations 20 and 21. **Dusenbery** presented on the smart board technology: use and purpose.

CM Longwell asked about the 911 Dispatch systems. He noted there had been some issues that may be affecting response times. **Dusenbery** responded he believed those had been addressed.
