3. WPD/Community Police Report

Officer B. Haught, WPD, reported on beats 16, 18, 19, and 199 and District V Neighborhoods.

- ✓ 16 Beat- no report
- ✓ 18 Beat-residential burglaries down 30%
- ✓ 19 Beat- residential burglaries down 25%. Traffic congestion on Tyler b/t 21st and 29th with road construction and construction workers vehicles parked along street.
- ✓ 199 Beat- residential burglaries down 47%. 7721 Harmony- case closed due to lack of complaints.
- ✓ OTHER: Liquor law special assignment- club enforcement. Swanson/ Buffalo park- special operation due to larcenies in area. Increase in coin operated (car washes) business larcenies. West of 119th residential burglaries- suspect identified possibly linked to nine cases.

4. Wichita Fire Department Report

Chief Tammy Snow, WFD, reported on July 2011 District V statistics:

- 27 fire incidents, 7 structure fires- using 108 resources
- 303 EMS and Rescue Alarms- using 392 resources
- 133 Service Alarms- using 218 resources

Other:

- Regional Training School starts 9/17- over 150 across the region registered.
- Fire Prevention Month in October with usual activities.
- Special programs at North East Magnet, West and North High Schools.
- Several Arson calls: 5608 W. 34th, 1522 S. 151st and 9948 W. Briarwood

Mike Green asked what WFD attributed the increase in fire calls to? **Snow** responded “hot and dry conditions”.

CM Longwell asked for a breakdown of calls that could have been handled by a squad vehicle. **Snow** would send that report out.
