RESOLUTION NO. 10-266

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE TO CONSTRUCT A MULTI-USE PATH BETWEEN MCADAMS PARK AND GROVE PARK (472-84910).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

The design and construction of a multi-use path.

SECTION 2: The cost of the construction of the above described improvements is estimated to be Two Million Forty-Eight Thousand Five Hundred Seventy-Three Dollars (\$2,048,573) exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money. To the extent the cost of such improvements is not paid by Federal Grants, administered by the Kansas Department of Transportation, the City of Wichita, Kansas is authorized to issue general obligation bonds to pay such costs under the authority of City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156 up to a maximum of \$2,048,573, exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established and authorized by City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
