RESOLUTION NO. 08-350

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE TO CONSTRUCT A BIKE PATH ALONG 21ST STREET, BETWEEN MAIZE ROAD AND ½ MILE WEST OF MAIZE ROAD (472-84739).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

The design and construction of a bike path and bike path rest areas.

SECTION 2: The total cost is estimated not to exceed \$50,000, exclusive of the costs of interest on borrowed money, with total paid by the issuance of bonds by the City of Wichita at large.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established as authorized by K.S.A. 13-1024c and City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
