### **3. WPD/Community Police Report**

**Officer Bradley Haught, WPD**, reported on beats 16, 18, 19, and 199.

- ✓ 16 Beat-
  - ✓ 18 Beat- although residential burglaries are still a concern there was a decrease in April.
  - ✓ 19 – Residential burglaries (7 in March, 6 in April). There was 1 arrest made that was ties to 6 theft cases on beat 199.
  - ✓ 199- residential burglaries (11 in March, 10 in April)

- 4/24- Law Enforcement Expo.
  - Credit was given to Officer Delana Long for her work on the bomb threat at Payne Elementary on 17 beat.
  - WPD has been proactive with financial crimes. Identified where the criminals are residing, passing photos for identification, and tracking vehicles.
  - Westlink NA Ice Cream Social scheduled for May 31 at Harvest Park.

### **4. Wichita Fire Department Report**

**Tom Carney, WFD**, reported on March District V Statistics: 8 fires, 3 structure fires, 289 Emergency calls, 68 service alarms.

- There was a small fire at 119<sup>th</sup> and Maple at the Walgreens store. An arrest was made in that case.
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Citizens Academy will be held starting on May 20<sup>th</sup>. 19 citizens are registered.

**Bryan Frye** asked if false alarms are recorded by district. **Carney** responded they are not recorded by district, but city wide.

**VM Longwell** commented that 95% of alarms set are false and set by irresponsible companies.

### **5. ZON2010-00013**

**Bill Longnecker, Planning**, presented on a request for an Amendment to Protective Overlays #s 63, 70, 113 and 117 on LC Limited Commercial zoned property. The proposed use is for outdoor speakers, drive through facilities, 20-foot tall pole lights and a maximum building height of 35 feet.

**DAB Members had the following questions and concerns:**

- Light poles & outdoor speakers/sound amplification system a possible interference to any of the residential areas.
- Trash hours: change from 6 a.m. to 8 a.m.
- Communication with residents
