RESOLUTION NO. 10-339

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE TO DESIGN AND IMPLEMENT AN INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM (472-84957).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

Improve the traffic signals, install message boards and install cameras along Kellogg, I-135 Freeway, I-235 Freeway, and K-96 Freeway in the City of Wichita, as necessary for an Intelligent Transportation System.

SECTION 2: The cost of the of the above described improvements is estimated to be Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money, with the total paid by the City of Wichita through the issuance of General Obligation Bonds.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established and authorized by City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
