3. WPD/Community Police Report

Officer Brad Haught, WPD, reported on beats 16, 18, 19, and 199 and District V Neighborhoods.

- ✓ 16 Beat-
- ✓ 18 Beat- Res burg still an issue. Robbery decreased. Agg. assaults increased
- ✓ 19 – Decrease in robbery, decrease in agg. Assault, increase in res. burg.
- ✓ 199- Homicide case. Auto thefts, res burg through open garage doors and access to garage door openers. Arrests made.

Other: Prostitution sting resulted in eight warrants on Asian spa's in District V. Three residential warrants.

Jay Flinn asked if human trafficking was involved. **Haught** reported although investigated, there were no findings.

Kelly Watkins asked about recent burglaries during real estate open houses. **Haught** responded an arrest had been made.

Joey Ellzey asked if the apartment complex at Central and Ridge, 734 N Ridge, had been "cleaned up" as it was reported to have been. **Haught** responded WPD is still working with that complex for improvement.
