RESOLUTION NO. 10-332

A RESOLUTION FIXING A TIME AND PLACE AND PROVIDING FOR NOTICE OF A HEARING BEFORE THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS, AT WHICH THE OWNER, HIS AGENT, LIENHOLDERS OF RECORD AND OCCUPANTS OF PROPERTY LEGALLY DESCRIBED AS: **LOTS 23, 25 AND 27, BLOCK 2, ESTERBROOK PARK ADDITION TO WICHITA, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS KNOWN AS 1030 N. POPLAR** MAY APPEAR AND SHOW CAUSE WHY SUCH STRUCTURE SHOULD NOT BE CONDEMNED AND ORDERED REPAIRED OR DEMOLISHED AS A DANGEROUS STRUCTURE.

WHEREAS, the enforcing officer of the City of Wichita, Kansas, did on the **21st day of December 2010**, file with the governing body of said city, a statement in writing that certain structure(s), hereinafter described, is unsafe or dangerous.

NOW THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Governing Body of the City of Wichita.

That a hearing will be held on the **1st day of February 2011**, before the governing body of the city at **9:30 A.M.**, or thereafter in the council room, City Building at which time the owner, his agent, any lienholders of record or any occupant of property, legally described at **LOTS 23, 25 AND 27, BLOCK 2, ESTERBROOK PARK ADDITION TO WICHITA, SEDGWICK COUNTY, KANSAS**, known as: **1030 N. POPLAR**, may appear and show cause why such structure should not be condemned as an unsafe or dangerous structure ordered repaired or demolished. The structure is a one story frame dwelling about 26 x 35 feet in size. Vacant for at least 11 months, this structure has shifting and cracking concrete block basement walls; rotted and missing wood siding; sagging and badly worn composition roof, with holes and missing shingles; deteriorated front porch; and the rotted framing members and wood trim.

Be it further resolved that the City Clerk shall cause this Resolution to be published and shall give notice of the aforesaid hearing in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-1752.
