RESOLUTION NO. 07-103

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE FOR THE RENOVATION OF OUTDATED AND DAMAGED RESTROOM FIXTURES AT CENTURY II.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1: That the City of Wichita finds it necessary to make certain related improvements as follows:

Labor, Material, and Equipment for the installation and repair of broken restroom fixtures and the upgrade from manual to automatic flush valves at Century II. The funding will replace 32 broken sinks, 18 urinal flush valves, 56 toilet flush valves and 20 shower enclosures.

SECTION 2: That the cost of said public improvements shall be paid by the issuance and sale of general obligation bonds by the City of Wichita at large, in the manner provided by law and under the authority of City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156. The total cost is estimated not to exceed \$74,976 exclusive of the costs of interest on borrowed money.

SECTION 3: That the advisability of said improvements is established as authorized by City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4: That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
