RESOLUTION NO. 06-659

A RESOLUTION FINDING IT NECESSARY TO COMPLETE A FLOOD STUDY TO THE **CHANNELS ALONG CALFSKIN CREEK AND DRY CREEK OF THE COWSKIN CREEK AND SAID TRIBUTARIES. 468-84269** AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE CITY OF WICHITA AT LARGE.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WICHITA, KANSAS;

SECTION 1. That the City of Wichita desires to complete a flood study for the Calfskin Creek, Dry Creek, Middle Fork Calfskin Creek, Northfork Calfskin Creek, and Northfork Calfskin Creek Tributary of the Cowskin drainage basin.

SECTION 2. That the cost of the study and updating the Federal flood maps is estimated to be \$600,000 exclusive of the cost of interest on borrowed money. Said cost, when ascertained, shall be borne by the City of Wichita at large by the issuance of general obligation bonds.

SECTION 3. That the advisability of said improvements is established as authorized by K.S.A. 13-1024c and City of Wichita Charter Ordinance No. 156.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and shall be published in the official City paper.
