Roadway and Pedestrian Lighting

Site lighting fixtures fall into two specific scales: roadway and pedestrian. Roadway lighting is rarely thought of as decorative but is used more for security and safety in large, mostly vehicular oriented places. Pedestrian lighting is brought down to human scale and is selected for its visual character as well as its safety attributes.

To strengthen the definition of the Nomar International District, matching roadway and pedestrian lighting are recommended. Black standards with matching, simple, historical style bases complement lanterns that have an international flair. The street lanterns are very decorative and the roadway lanterns have a distinct design that is different than any other area. The inclusion of these fixtures will help define the boundaries of the district along the street right-of-way as well as within the public spaces. Each pole can be fitted with brackets that can display colorful and informative banners to further define the area.

Wall brackets and hanging brackets are available if a designer wished to incorporate the street lantern into architectural design.
