3. Community Police Report

Community Police Officers will report on current community policing issues in District IV.

NEW BUSINESS

4. Sales Tax Relief

Budget staff will present a concept that could allow the property tax mill levy to be reduced from the present 32 mills to as low as 15 mill (a reduction of 17 mills). A proposed city-wide one cent sales tax would be used to offset the revenue lost.

Recommended Action: Receive and file.

5. Maize Road Improvements, between Pawnee and Kellogg

Public Works staff will present this project. The proposed improvement consists of a five-lane roadway with two through lanes in each direction and a center two-way left-turn lane. The project will reconstruct Maize Road from just north of the improved intersection at Pawnee to Kellogg. Drainage improvements will be included with the project. A five foot sidewalk will be constructed on both sides of Maize Road, and the available right-of-way will be landscaped. The intersection of Pawnee and Maize will be evaluated to see if traffic signals installation is warranted.

Recommended Action: Recommend approval of the project.

6. Meridian Street Improvements, between 47th St. South and 31st St. South

Public Works staff will present this project. The proposed improvement consists of a five-lane roadway with two through lanes in each direction and a center two-way left-turn lane between 47th St. S. and 33rd St. S. Meridian will remain a four lane roadway between 33rd St. S. and 31st St. S. Left-turn lanes will be provided at the 31st & Meridian intersection and the traffic signals will be upgraded. The intersection at 47th & Meridian will be improved with a separate project. Traffic signals will be installed at the I-235 access ramps. Drainage improvements will be included with the project as well as 5' sidewalk on both sides of Meridian, except for the west side between 31st and 33rd.

Recommended Action: Recommend approval of the project.
