



2019 Water Conservation Rebate Program SMART IRRIGATION CONTROLLERS REBATE

Smart Irrigation Controller Rebate: \$100.00 for a new and installed stand-alone or add-on irrigation controller that waters a landscape using Wichita, KS evapotranspiration (ET) values, & replaces a conventional irrigation clock (New Construction isn't eligible).

Rebate is available for all customers having active accounts with the City of Wichita Public Works and Utilities for delivery of potable water. Systems using well water aren't eligible.

Specifications

The smart irrigation controller must be WaterSense certified and labeled. The irrigation system on which it is installed must be connected to city water and have a legal and registered cross connection (backflow) controller. For a complete list of the approved controllers visit:

Instructions

- Smart irrigation controller must be purchased and installed between Jan. 1, 2019 and Dec. 31, 2019. Rebate is available on a first come, first served basis subject to funds availability.
- Mail rebate application along with the required information to the address at the bottom of this page. You have 90 days after date of purchase to mail in the application and required information for the rebate.
- Original copies of required information must be provided to verify purchase and installation. *Failure to provide the required information will result in the rebate request being denied.*
- Required information **must** accompany the application and this includes:
 1. Original invoice or sales receipt showing date and place of sale, date of installation, along with an itemized description of purchase and cost of item. Original installation receipts must be provided if installation is not completed by company of purchase. Carbon copies count as the originals. Online purchases, submit printout of final invoice and original packing or delivery slip. Photocopies will not be accepted.
 2. Original proof of purchase with complete barcode, if self-installed.
- An inspection may be required, and the smart irrigation controller must be properly installed and functioning at the time of inspection.
- There is a limit of 5 qualifying devices per active Water Utilities account, mixed or matched.
- Dispose of old irrigation controller in a manner that prevents its reuse. Recycle it if possible.
- Rebate amount will not exceed the actual purchase price of a smart irrigation controller, and excludes taxes and costs of installation.
- Rebates will be credited to applicant's water utility account.
