



2020 Water Conservation Rebate Program RAIN SENSOR-SHUTOFF REBATE

Rain Sensor-Shutoff Rebate: \$100.00 for a new and installed rain sensor-shutoff that interrupts an automated irrigation system operation after ¼-inch of rain has been received.

Rebate is available for all customers having active accounts with the City of Wichita Public Works and Utilities for delivery of landscape irrigation water from the potable system. Systems using well water for irrigation are not eligible.

Specifications

The rain sensor-shutoff device must be able to turn off and keep irrigation system off after ¼-inch of rain has been received, and then not let the irrigation system run again until landscape is dry enough that it needs to be irrigated. The irrigation system on which it is installed must be connected to city water and have a legal and registered cross connection (backflow) controller.

Instructions

- Rain sensor-shutoff must be purchased and installed between Jan. 1, 2020 and Dec. 31, 2020. The rebate is available on a first come first served basis, subject to the availability of funds.
- The online application link is at the bottom of this page. You have 90 days after date of purchase in which to fill out the application and required information for the rebate.
- Original copies of required information must be provided to verify purchase.
Failure to provide the required information will result in the rebate request being denied.
- Required information ***must*** accompany the application and this includes:
 1. Sale invoice(s) to be uploaded with online application.
- There is a limit of 5 qualifying devices per active Water Utilities account, mixed or matched.
- An old rain sensor-shutoff must be properly disposed of in a manner that will prevent its reuse. Please recycle it if at all possible.
- Rebate amount will not exceed the actual purchase price of rain sensor-shutoff, and excludes taxes and costs of installation.
- Rebates will be credited to applicant's water utility account.
