

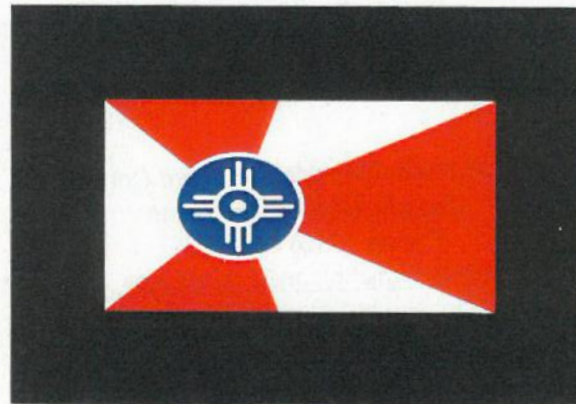
The Findings:

Following an investigation, the Professional Standards Bureau will notify the individual making the complaint in writing of the findings. There are six (6) possible findings:

- **Sustained:** An allegation is supported by sufficient evidence to justify a reasonable conclusion of a violation of policy.
- **Not Sustained:** Insufficient evidence exists to either prove or disprove the allegation
- **Exonerated:** Incident occurred, but was lawful and proper.
- **Unfounded:** Allegation[s] is [are] false or not factual.
- **Non-Discipline Education/Training:** The result of the investigation proved the incident did not violate department policy or procedure; however, during the review, supervision found the employee could benefit from educational training.
- **Non-Discipline Mediation:** After reviewing the incident and based on voluntary participation, it was best determined to problem solve through mediation to identify factors that led to the complaint.

Citizens Review Board (CRB)

Description

The Wichita Citizen's Review Board assists the Wichita Police Department with community outreach and advises the Police Department about community concerns. The Board serves to provide assistance in policy development, education, and communications related to racial and other biased-based policing. The Board also will conduct reviews of post-discipline findings of the Professional Standards Bureau in alleged officer misconduct matters upon the request of the Chief of Police. These members are appointed by the City Manager.

Purpose

The City of Wichita maintains a number of Citizen Advisory Boards and Commissions. The purpose of these groups is to pay specialized attention to certain areas affecting our community and to make recommendations to better inform City Council decisions. These groups range from library operations, to urban planning, to park activities, and much more. There are also six (6) District Advisory Boards, which make recommendations to City Council and City staff on a number of wide ranging issues.
