Media Advisory Robbery Arrest

The Wichita Police Department (WPD) today arrested a 32-year-old male in connection with two recent robberies. The male has been booked into Sedgwick County Jail on two counts of robbery, possession of drug paraphernalia, and aggravated weapons violation.

On Saturday at approximately 6 p.m., officers responded to a robbery call at the Taco Bell in the 7300 block of West 21st north. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a 23-year-old male employee. The employee reported an unknown suspect approached the counter and handed him a note demanding money. Money was taken by the suspect and the suspect fled the business on foot. There were no reported injuries in the incident. The case number is 18C007664.

On Friday at approximately 6:20 p.m., officers responded to a robbery call at the Burger King in the 700 block of North Tyler. Upon arrival, officers made contact with a 17-year-old male employee who reported an unknown suspect entered the store and handed him a note demanding money. Money was given to the suspect who then fled the store on foot. The case number is 18C007455.

The cases will be presented to the Sedgwick County District Attorney's Office.
