Media Advisory WPD Make Arrest in DV Case

Today, Wichita Police Department (WPD) Officers arrested a 32-year-old male on a domestic violence charge that occurred Friday.

Officers received information that the male involved in the case was at a residence in the 2900 block of east Sennett.

At approximately 11 a.m. on Friday, Officers observed the male leaving in a black Toyota Corolla displaying a stolen license plate. Officers attempted to stop the vehicle when the driver refused to stop. He accelerated and fled in the vehicle.

Officers disregarded the chase due to excessive speeds in the area of Central and Hillside. Officers were able to contact the male by cell phone. He stated he was armed and wanted to harm himself.

Two WPD hostage negotiators assisted with the case. Through the Officers' effective communication, the suspect returned to the residence on Sennett after approximately 30 minutes. He was taken into custody without incident. The male was booked into jail on charges of robbery, criminal deprivation of a vehicle, aggravated assault, domestic violence battery, evade and elude, criminal use of weapons, possession of drug paraphernalia and traffic charges.
