Media Advisory 27-Year-Old Woman Found Dead

The Wichita Police Department (WPD) early Friday morning responded to a call and found the body of a 27-year-old woman, Emily Glass. It was reported she committed suicide. Her death is being investigated and the cause of death will be determined by the Coroner's Office.

At approximately 1:40 a.m., on Friday, Glass' boyfriend, 34-year-old Jonathan Hernandez called 911 to report arriving home and finding Glass dead. Officers discovered a rifle near her feet, and three suicide notes in the residence, 655 S. Edgemoor.

Glass' body is at the Regional Forensic Science Center. The case number is 18C036793.

Glass had been questioned in the disappearance and death of 5-year-old Lucas Hernandez, the son of Jonathan. On May 24, she was booked into Sedgwick County Jail for felony obstruction of justice, after leading a private investigator to Lucas' body under a bridge in Harvey County. Lucas had been missing since Feb. 17.

The homicide investigation into Lucas' death is ongoing. The case number is 18C010693.
