Media Advisory 1600 S. Erie Homicide

At approximately 10:30 p.m., yesterday Wichita Police Department (WPD) Officers responded to a cutting call in the 1600 block of south Erie and located a 68-year-old male in the street who was pronounced dead.

Through the investigation it was learned the victim was driving his 2007 black Chevy Z71 Silverado extended cab pick-up truck north on Erie. The truck stopped and a disturbance ensued in the street between the victim and suspect. The victim was stabbed multiple times by the suspect who then fled in the victim's black Chevy. The suspect is described as an unknown b/m, 5'08"-5'11", 250lbs, and wearing a light colored hat. The truck has chrome rims, a chrome handle on the tailgate and the passenger window has been taped up. The truck also had a 60-day tag.

The investigation is ongoing and it is not believed to be a random event. No arrests have been made at this time.
