Media Advisory Stabbing, 2232 S. Broadway

The Wichita Police Department (WPD) arrested 26-year-old Teka Pardue on charges of attempted 1st degree murder, aggravated weapons violation and possession of drug paraphernalia.

At approximately 9:30 p.m. on Sunday, Officers responded to an unknown call for EMS at the Relax Inn, 2232 S. Broadway. Upon arrival, Officers located a 25-year-old female with a laceration to her neck. The female was transported to an area hospital for medical treatment. She is in critical, but stable condition.

Also, upon arriving, Officers contacted Pardue armed with a knife. Officers gave Pardue verbal commands, she dropped the knife and was taken into custody without incident.

The investigation revealed Pardue and the victim got into a verbal argument, and Pardue stabbed the victim one time, causing injury.

Pardue was arrested and booked into jail for attempted 1st degree murder, aggravated weapons violation and possession of drug paraphernalia.

The investigation is ongoing and the case number is 18C069241. The case will be presented to the District Attorney's Office.
