### **WSCLETC Temporary Fingerprinting Services Protocols**

The Wichita/Sedgwick County Law Enforcement Training Center (WSCLETC), 4310 19<sup>th</sup> Street, fingerprinting, and private security licensing services remain operational by appointment only during the COVID-19 pandemic. This temporary operational change ensures the safety to the community and staff.

Appointments are available Monday through Friday, from 8 a.m. to 11 a.m., and from 1 p.m. to 3 p.m.. Fingerprint processing continues for medical, school, childcare providers, and private security employees. Appointments are made by calling 316-660-3810.

When arriving at the WSCLETC for fingerprinting and security licensing services, the following protocols are now in effect:

- If you arrive early to your fingerprint appointment or security license, wait in your vehicle until the time of your appointment;
- Before entering the WSCLETC, everyone entering the building must use the handwashing station just outside of the front door;
- Once inside, your temperature will be checked with a touchless thermometer, and you will be asked the following screening questions - are you experiencing a new or worsening cough, shortness of breath, or fever?;
- All clients must have a temperature below 100.4 (as recommended by the CDC);
- If the client has a temperature at or above the CDC recommended level, they are denied services at that time; and
- Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is available for use while inside of the WSCLETC.

The WSCLETC is otherwise closed to the general public. However, the Wichita Police Department (WPD) observed the need for these identified groups to continue their efforts in filling much-needed positions in our community.
