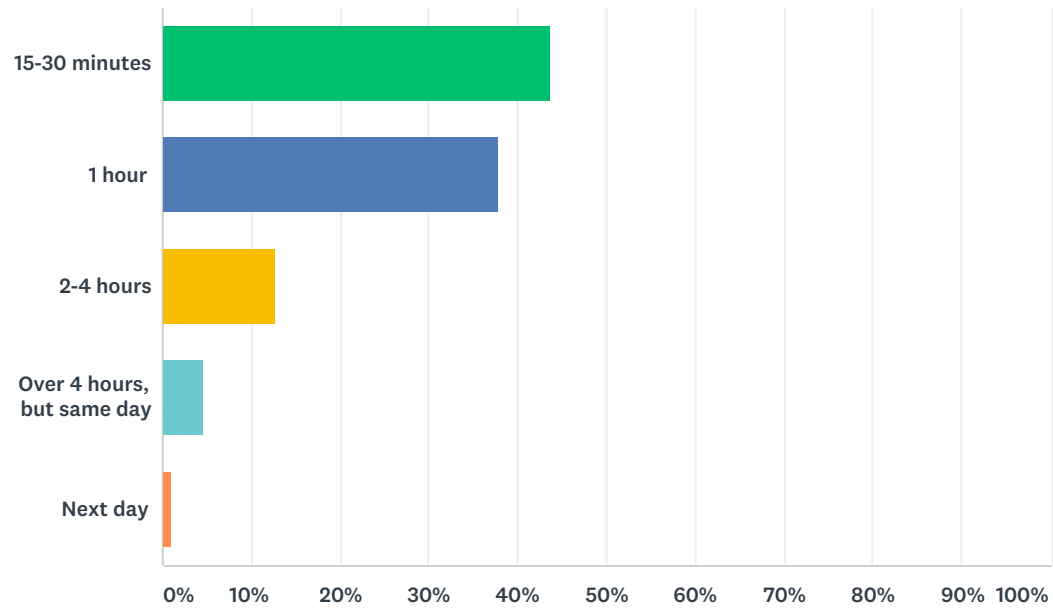


# Q1 When calling for an Animal Control Officer regarding an issue, what is an acceptable response time for their arrival on scene?

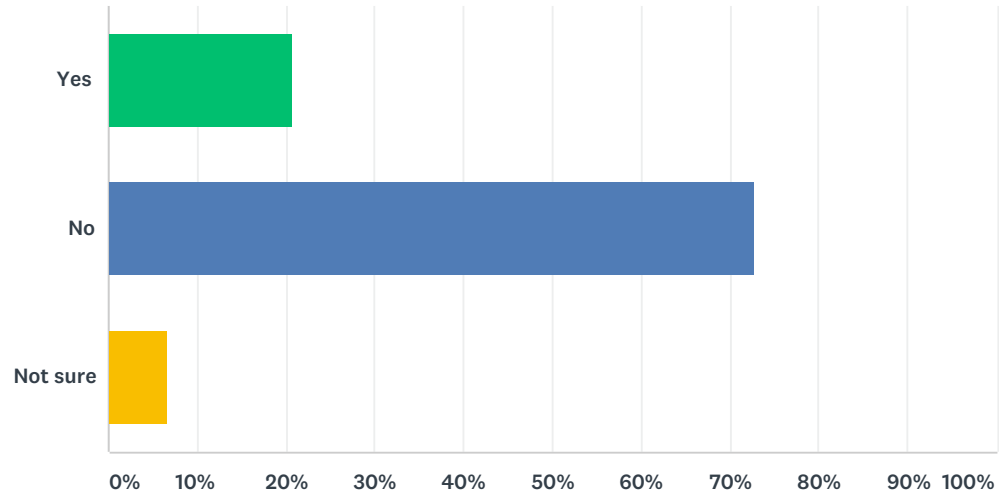

## Q2 Do you feel that feral cats are a nuisance in your neighborhood?

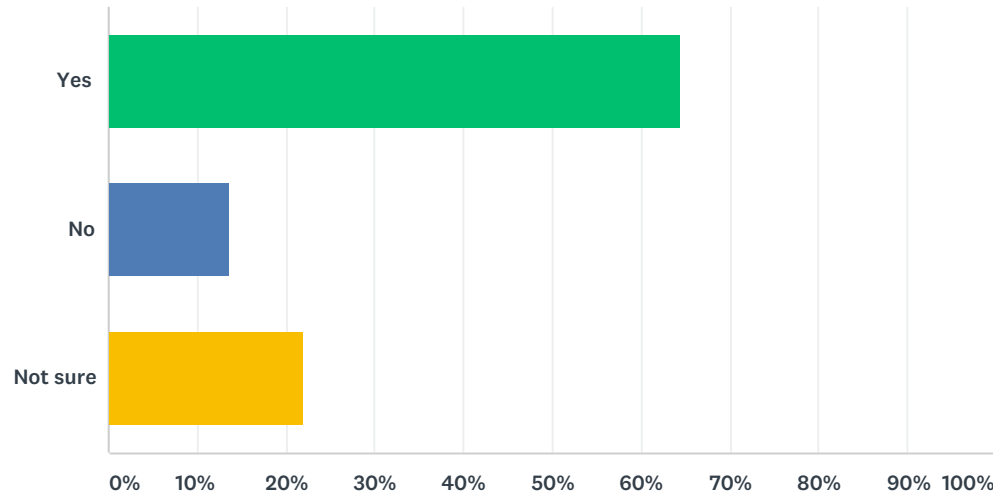

### Q3 Should the City of Wichita take an active role in assisting neighborhoods with a feral cat issue?

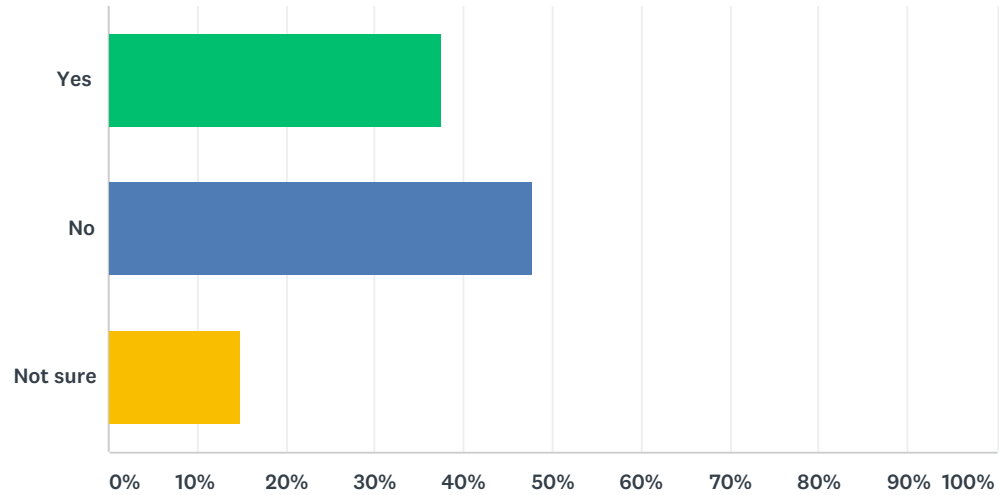

### Q4 Some cities require that cats be licensed. Do you support this?

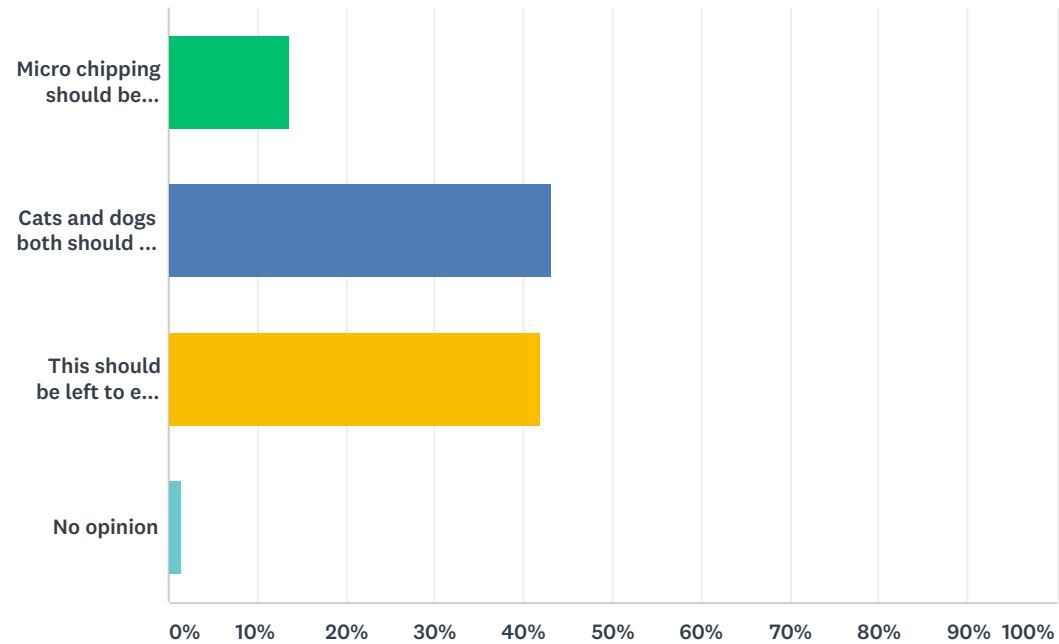

### Q5 Micro chipped pets have a greater chance of being reunited with their owner. What should the city position be on this issue?

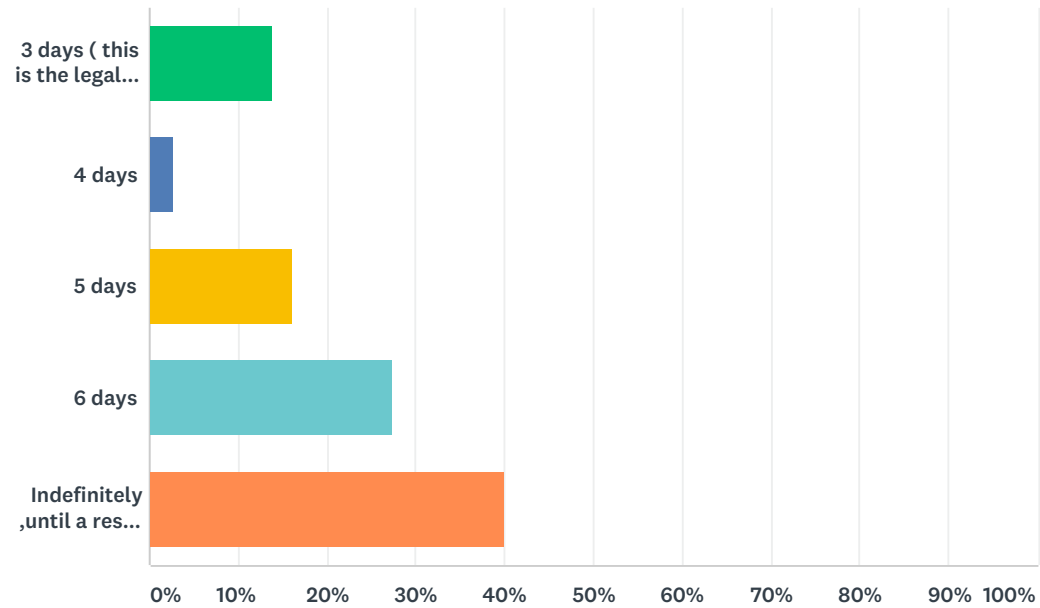

## Q6 When an animal is brought into the shelter, how many days should it be held to allow the owner to reclaim it?

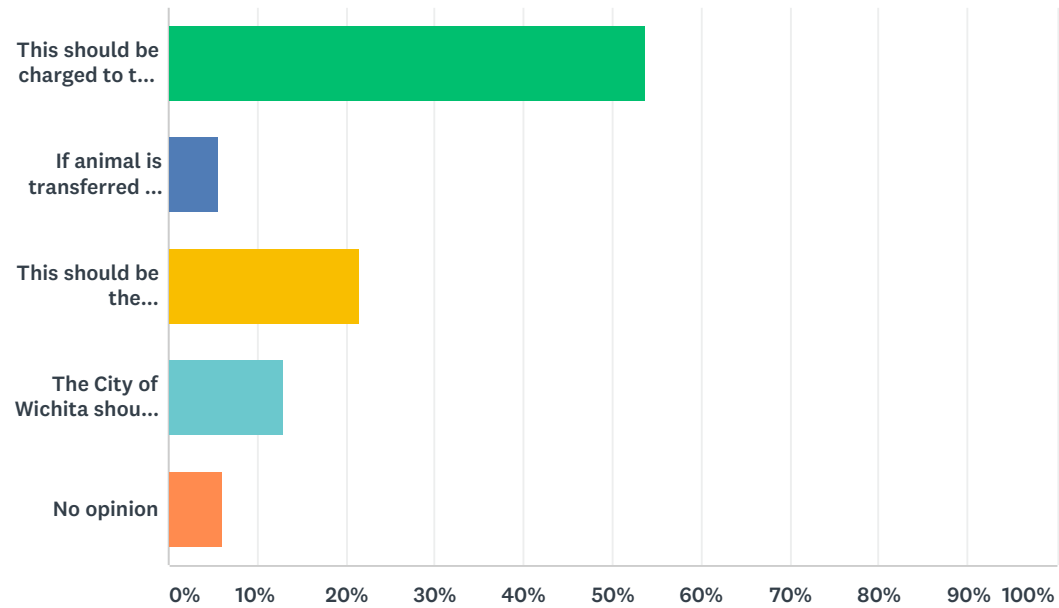

## Q7 If animals are at the shelter longer than the legally required 3 day holding period, who should be responsible for the cost of their care?

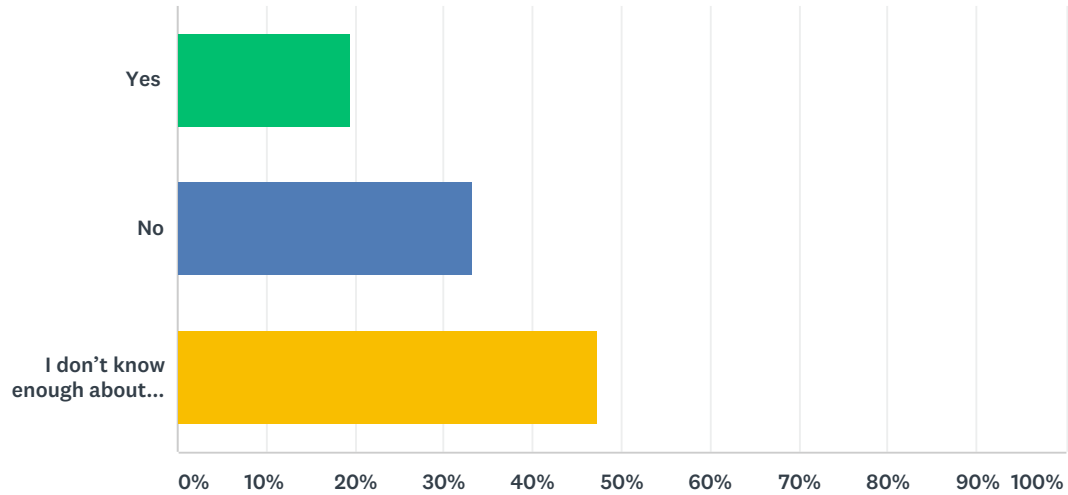

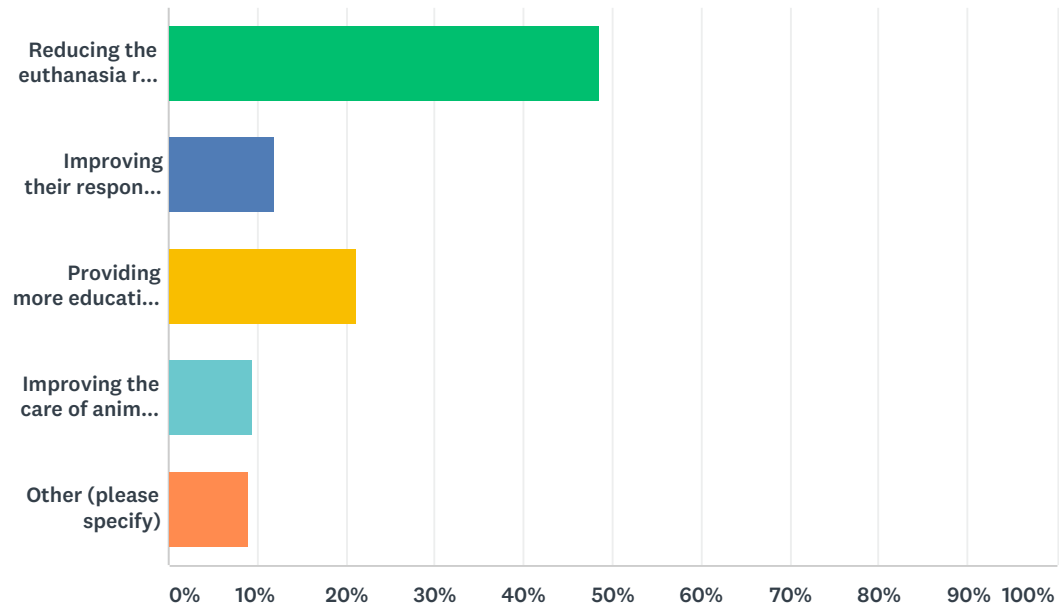

### Q9 What do you consider to be the most pressing issue for Animal Control to improve upon for 2018? (please choose only 1 )

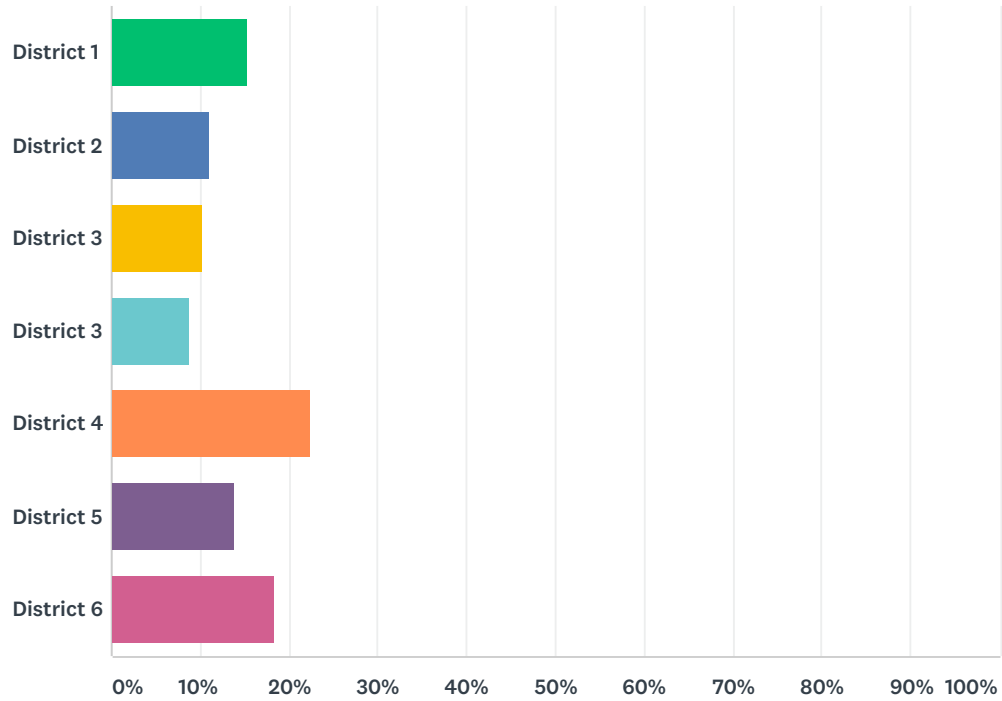

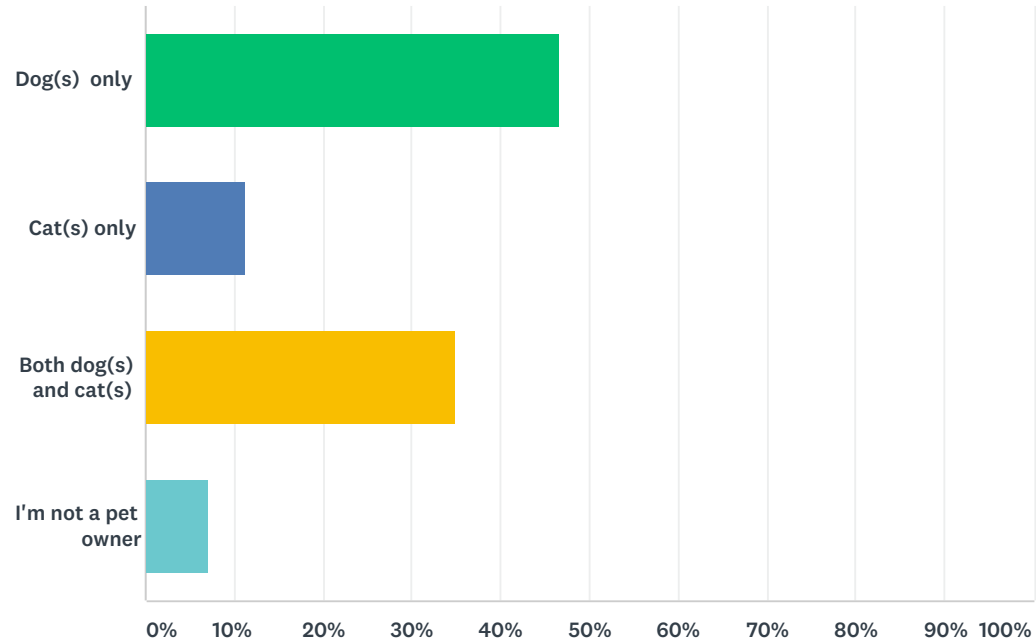
