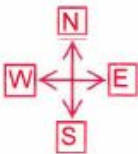

- Street closure requests approved April 16, 2018
 - South Martinson Street, West Maple Street to Burton Street
- Area businesses and residents have been notified of the street closure

St. Mary's Orthodox Church Food Festival - Community Event with Alcohol Consumption

- City Code requires a resolution authorizing consumption of alcoholic liquor on public streets
- Proposed TED includes:
 - The 300 block of South Martinson Street from the north curb line of West Maple Street, extending north to the south curb line of West Burton Avenue
- Staff has reviewed the application for the Community Event with the consumption of alcoholic liquor allowed and finds that criteria has been met
