

2020 Pedestrian Corridor Safety Improvements (District VI)

Background



The Pedestrian Corridor Safety Improvements were funded in the year 2020 in the 2019-2028 Capital Improvement Program (CIP).



Analysis



The project is intended to make pedestrian/bicycle safety improvements to primary corridors. The 2020 funding will be used for McLean Boulevard from Central Avenue to 13th Street North and the pedestrian crossing near 10th Street North. Any remaining funding would be used to provide the same type of improvements for another priority corridor. The neighborhood improvements funding that was to be used for the McLean Boulevard project will be used for other.



Financial Considerations



The 2019-2028 CIP includes funding for Pedestrian Corridor Safety Improvements in the amount of \$500,000 for 2020, which is funded by General Obligation bonds. Staff recommends initiating \$500,000 at this time.



Recommendation/Action



Approve the budget, adopt the resolution, and authorize the necessary signatures.



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
