Background

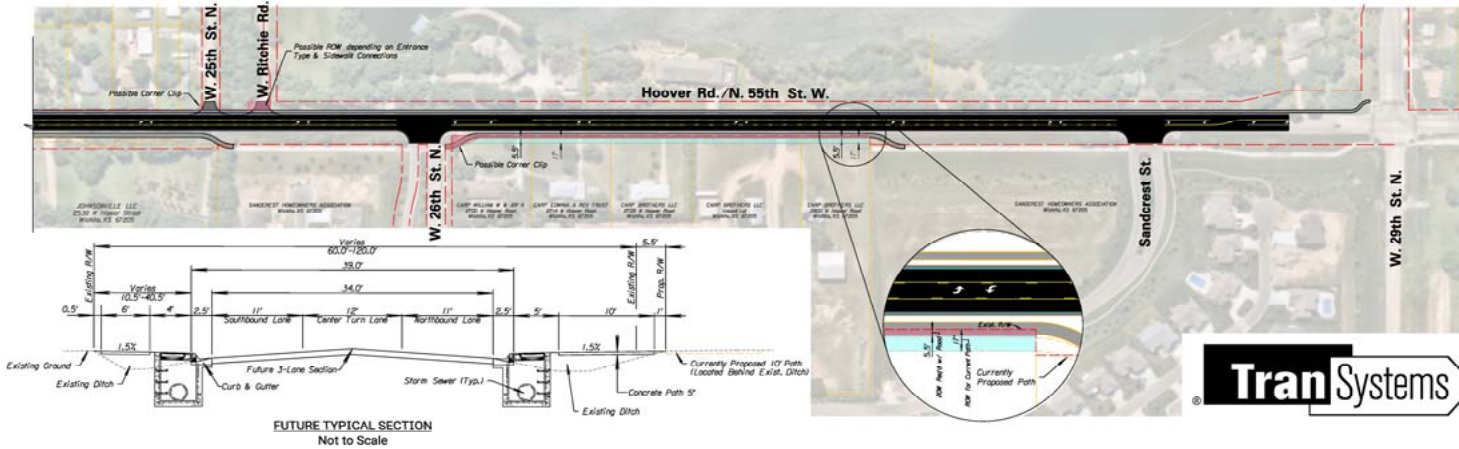
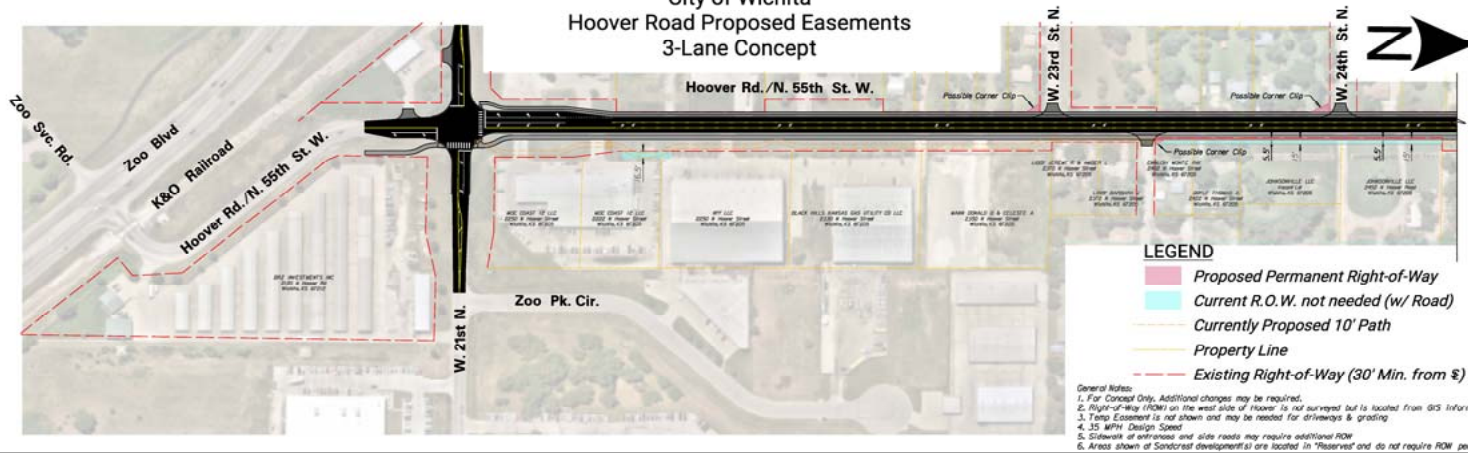


- On September 13, 2021, District Advisory Board VI unanimously approved the proposed design concept for Hoover Road, Zoo Blvd to 29th Street North.
- On October 5, 2021, the City Council approved the proposed design concept. On November 30, 2021, the Staff Screening and Selection Committee interviewed two consulting firms that responded to the City's request for design of the project.
- TranSystems was selected for the design based on their approach, extensive knowledge and expertise for the area and past performances on similar projects.

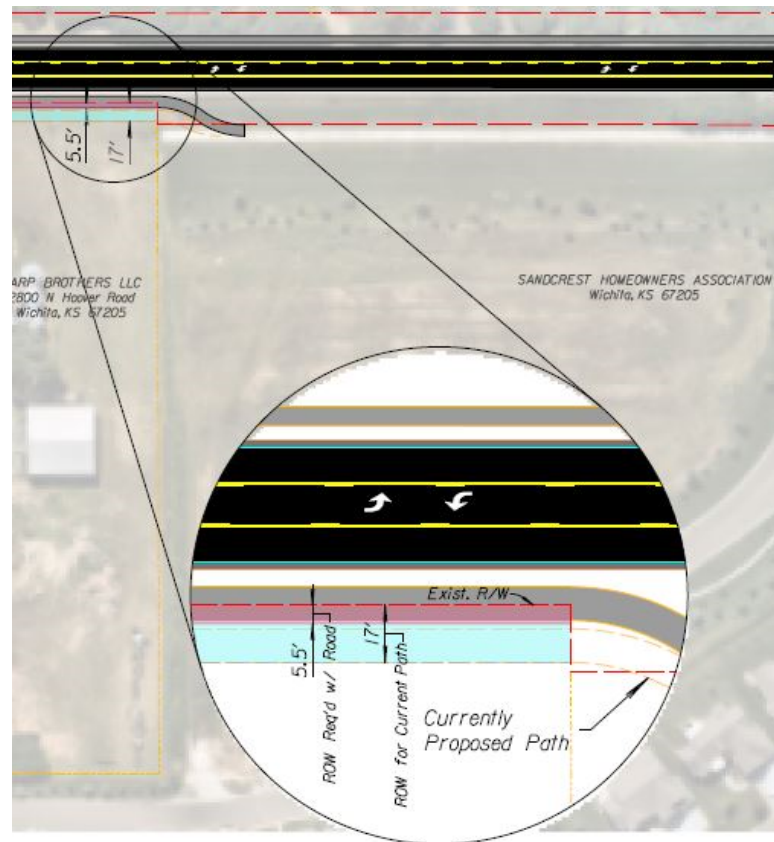


Hoover Road 3-Lane Concept

Financials



- The cost of the Design Services Agreement is \$355,000. Staff recommends transferring \$400,000 in funding available from cost savings from the Hoover Road Multi-Use Path from Zoo Boulevard to 29th Street North. Staff requests waiver of City Council Policy No. 2 regarding the use of project savings to allow this transfer of funds.
- The Adopted 2022-2031 Capital Improvement Program includes \$500,000 in Local Sales Tax funding for Hoover Road, Zoo Boulevard to 29th North. Staff recommends initiating \$500,000 at this time. The total revised budget would be \$900,000 for design, right-of-way and staff time.



Recommendation/Action



Approve the Design Services Agreement, new and revised budgets, adopt the resolution and amending resolution, waive City Council Policy No. 2 regarding the use of project savings to allow the transfer of funds, and authorize the necessary signatures.



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
