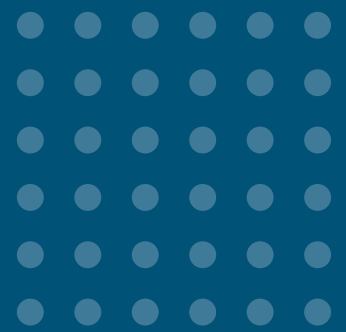

Background



- The City has been awarded \$72.4 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) State and Local Recovery Funds (SLRF)
- The use of ARPA was discussed during 2022 Budget process, including public hearings
- ARPA funding must be spent consistent with US Treasury guidelines



City ARPA Plan



- The 2022 Adopted Budget includes a conceptual plan for the use of ARPA funds during the 2021 to 2024 planning period
- Three projects have been approved: Fire Station Alerting System; Workforce and Small Business grants; and vaccination clinic funding
- Two additional projects are recommended for approval today



Continuing ARPA Implementation



ARPA projects recommended:

- Program Administration - The project will provide funding for program compliance and indirect costs of administering ARPA funds
- Fire Response Optimization - Staff costs to develop and implement a new optimized response model



Recommendation



- Approve two ARPA projects
 - \$925,000 - Program Administration
 - \$250,000 - Fire Response Optimization
