

- Requesting an Economic Development Exemption (EDX) tax abatement
- EDX is a State of Kansas program
- Manufacturing, warehousing and distribution or research and development of products used in interstate commerce



- Additional location at 2700 S. Custer (south and west of Pawnee & Meridian)
- Add an expansion (39,000 sf total)
- \$2,290,000 (real property) + \$1,500,000 (M&E) = \$3,790,000
- 26 new jobs (492 base employees); Average annual wage \$42,291
- Job creation 40%, capital investment 40%, Regional Growth Plan sector 10%, utilizing State of Kansas incentives 10% = 100%

- Under former EDX program, company would start construction, provide
 City with a letter of intent to apply for the abatement once project was
 complete
- That program was changed to require the approval up front
- LTC was unaware and started construction like they did with previous expansion



Value of one year 100% tax abatement

• City \$18,749 State \$ 858

• County\$16,817 USD 259 \$30,327
