

Amendments to Title 4 regarding CMB and Temporary Alcohol Permits

History



During the most recent legislative session, the Legislature amended state statutes regarding CMB and Temporary Alcohol Permits.

Amendments are necessary to bring the City's Ordinances into compliance with State Statutes.



Background



- The amendments repeal standards for CMB retailers' permits that are no longer required by state law.
- Section 4.16.060 is amended to reduce the fee for an alcohol temporary permit to a non-refundable fee of \$25 per day to ensure consistency with state law.
- Section 4.16.154(c) is amended to increase the limit of number of temporary permits that may be obtained per year from 4 to 12 to be consistent with state law.



Recommendations/Actions



- It is recommended that the City Council place the amendments on first reading and authorize all necessary signatures.
